

# Wine - Windows Emulator

Wine is used for running Windows based programs on Linux. [www.winehq.com](http://www.winehq.com) Wine is not very stable, and as a result, I strongly suggest you look for a similar program with similar functionality. Do a "apt-cache search program" to search for packages/programs.

## Install Wine

```
apt-get install wine
```

```
apt-get install winesetuptk
```

```
//This is a gui for setting up wine for a user. It sets up a fake_windows main folder etc.
```

```
apt-get install wine-utils
```

```
//This provides tools such as "regedit" which can simply be run as "regedit" from the cmdline to show
```

## Run a Windows Program/Installer in Wine

```
wine programinstall.exe
```

```
wine notepad.exe
```
